MUSIC SCHOLARSHIP AUDITION GUIDELINES: Please choose one piece that demonstrates musical contrast, or two short pieces that do so. A student should be prepared to demonstrate sufficient skill on the instrument to merit placement in a college-level performance ensemble. Scholarship winners do not need to be music majors to win an award. Students wishing to audition for a music scholarship must choose a single discipline in which to do so. Music majors who wish to audition for scholarships must do so in the discipline matching his/her Applied Music studies and ensemble participation.
SUGGESTED REPERTOIRE CONSIDERATIONS: PIANO: An etude, or the 1st movement (or excerpt) of a sonata (i.e. by Bach, Beethoven, Mozart, Brahms, Chopin, etc.) VOICE: A vocal selection from the standard art song or operatic literature in English, Italian, German or French (i.e. songs by Britten, Vaughan Williams, Copland, Caldara, Scarlatti, Puccini, Mozart, Schubert, Brahms, Debussy, Fauré. In some cases, musical theatre literature is acceptable, but please do not choose selections that require rock or pop-style belting. STRINGS, WOODWINDS, BRASS & GUITAR: A selection or two short selections or excerpt(s) from the standard solo repertoire or an etude demonstrating contrasting style and tempi (fast vs. slow and lyrical). Suggested composers: Bach, Brahms, Ferling (studies), Finzi, Handel, Haydn, Mozart, Telemann, Schubert, Villa Lobos, Vivaldi, etc. PERCUSSION: One etude or movement showing a variety of techniques (timpani, snare); Mallet skills and scales if appropriate JAZZ STYLES: Performance (melody and improvisation) of one or two tunes from the standard jazz repertoire in contrasting styles, such as a medium or medium up-tempo 12-bar jazz blues or standard jazz tune and/or a standard ballad. (Playback CDs to accompany jazz auditions are fine.) *Drummers demonstrate both solo and accompaniment contrasting styles. *Pianists & Guitar: Also demonstrate comping in various styles.
THE SRJC MUSIC FACULTY WILL DESIGNATE THE PERFORMANCE CO- REQUISITE FOR EACH INDIVIDUAL MUSIC SCHOLARSHIP WINNER: Voice - MUSCP 21ABCD Concert Choir Woodwind, Brass, Percussion, Jazz Guitar, Jazz Piano or String Bass (as designated!) MUSCP 30ABCD Symphonic Band or MUSCP 32ABCD Jazz Band or MUSCP 42ABCD Jazz Combos Ensemble Strings - MUSCP 33ABCD Orchestra Classical Piano - Orchestra, Symphonic Band (as designated!) Classical Piano & Classical Guitar scholarship awards may be limited to students who are enrolled in the Applied Music program and in an approved co-requisite ensemble at SRJC.
